

Surveyors from the Belarusian company Credo-Dialog directed by D.V. Chadovich in collaboration with the St. Petersburg SS&M (V.B. Kaptjug) conducted volunteer field surveys at the Belarus' principal Struve arc station "Belin". Through measurements and excavations of their own, as well as questioning the local residents they proved safety, material appearance and the exact coordinates of the two main markers of the station. The results of the work have been reported in September at a meeting of the Coordinating committee on the WH "Struve arc", then the event was highlighted in various media.
